

YMCA Camp Twin Lakes

Cabin use policies



- 11:00pm – 7:00am is designated as “quiet hours” for the Park and grounds.
- No pets are allowed in facilities. There is a City “Leash Law” in effect for day use guests.
- The YMCA Facility is a TOBACCO FREE area. No smoking is allowed in or around any Building.
- The YMCA prohibits OPEN CARRY of Hand Guns within their Facilities and buildings.
- Check-In/Out times are indicated on your rental agreement.
- Please use common courtesy at our Camp by keeping it clean, reporting any problems or damages, taking garbage to the outside bins and not re-arranging furniture.
- Cleaning: Each cabin will be cleaned and inspected for damage after use. Before departure, please assure that no personal belongings are left (check beds and under mattresses), that the trash is placed in trash cans, toilets are flushed and lights are out. Set thermostat to 76f. Kitchenette (if used) should be wiped down, trash disposed of and refrigerator and cupboards cleared out. Check the porch area as well. The \$250 security deposit will be credited back after inspection.
- Tampering with or damaging the smoke/fire alarm and suppression system will result in actual repair and clean up charges.
- Maintenance and Access: The YMCA has the right to enter the Cabin at any time during guest stay and we will diligently attempt to address maintenance issues as they occur. If a maintenance issue occurs that cannot be fixed in a reasonable amount of time or if the Cabin is unavailable for any reason as determined in our discretion, and significantly affects your stay; we reserve the right to refund at our discretion or offer to relocate you to another Cabin.
- Phone and Internet: We do not provide a land line phones for Cabins and suggest that you please use your mobile phone or Wi-Fi enabled phone for calls.
- Weather and Other Unforeseen Events: The YMCA does not accept liability for any inconveniences arising from any temporary defects or stoppage in supply of water, gas, electricity or plumbing, damage caused by weather/road conditions, natural disasters, acts of God or other reasons beyond its control. No refunds will be given for any delays or cancellations due to such conditions. Travel Insurance is highly recommended for any stay.
- Security: YMCA Camp Twin Lakes is located within a public County Park and as such, the park grounds cannot be completely secured. Cabins should be kept locked and your personal belongings and valuables should be kept out of sight. Vehicles should also be locked with valuables hidden from view. It is the responsibility of the guest to collect any items that are left behind at Camp.
- LOST KEYS: or keys that are not returned will incur at \$150 charge to cover the cost of rekeying the cabin.
- Indemnity: The YMCA does not assume any liability for loss, theft, damage or injury to Guest, his/her guests or other occupants in the facility. The Guest, for himself/herself, his/her heirs, assignors, executors and administrators, fully releases and discharges YMCA from any and all claims, demands and causes of action by reason of any injury or whatever nature which has or have occurred, or may occur to the Guest, his/her guests or other occupants of the facility as a result of, or in connection with the occupancy of the cabin and agrees to hold YMCA free and harmless of any claim or suit arising therefrom. In any action concerning the rights, duties or liabilities of the parties to this Agreement, or their principals, agents, successors or assignees the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorney fees and costs.
